DIGITAL CAMERA CLASS – PART 3

E-MAIL

Recommended for 1-3 photos, using smaller file/photo sizes. Assuming that your photos are edited, re-sized and saved to your computer/CD/USB Flash drive:

1. Open your e-mail program.
2. Compose a new e-mail.
3. Click on Attach.
4. Choose your photo(s) from the appropriate drive and folder.
5. Send your e-mail.

UPLOADING

Recommended for many photos, using any various photo sizes. Assuming that your photos are edited and saved to your computer/CD/USB Flash drive:

Great for printing photos, creating and sharing albums and storing your photos.*

1. Login or create an account.
2. Click on Upload Photos.
3. Create a new album (ex. 2010 ZB Library Camera Class) or upload to an existing album.
4. Add contacts if you want to share your album (e-mail addresses).
5. Choose your upload settings - usually Fast Upload. You may want to uncheck the Automatic Photo Correction, if you've already edited your photos.
6. Select your photos from the appropriate drive and folder. Note the "upload tip" in the upper right-hand corner - tells you how to easily select multiple photos.
7. Upload.
8. When finished uploading, you can view photos, go to the store, or upload more (maybe from a different drive/folder).
9. You can play the slideshow, view your library, see Friend's albums, and join groups.
10. To share the album, click on Share an Album and add e-mail addresses. Add a personal message and hit Share Album.
11. To share as a link: click on that tab and copy and paste the code into an email (click on the code, right click to copy, go to your e-mail and right-click to paste).
12. Share to Facebook, etc.
13. Create and share to a Group Room (where you'll invite contacts to upload their similar photos).

1. Login or create an account.
2. Upload Photos & Videos.
3. Choose photos and videos.
4. Select your photos from the appropriate drive and folder.
5. Set privacy - Private (Friends/Family) - you will have to enter their e-mail addresses to give them permission to view your photos OR Public (anyone can see them).

6. Click on Upload Photos and Videos.
7. After they are finished uploading, you can Add a Description.
8. Add TAGS to all photos under Batch Operations. You can also add to a set or create a new set. Tagging photos and putting them into a set helps with organizing.
9. Rename your photos if you wish and add a description.
10. Save.
11. View a slideshow or “Share This”.
12. Enter addresses to e-mail an invitation to or “Grab the Link” and copy/paste it into an e-mail.

Note photos cannot be downloaded (by anyone) with a free Flickr account. You have to upgrade to the Pro account for this to work. There is no batch download option.

Facebook: Great for sharing photos, creating and sharing albums and storing your photos.*

1. Login or create an account.
2. From the News Feed, click on the empty status update box. You can choose Upload a Photo from your drive or Create and Album with many photos. We'll create an album. Click on Select Photos.
3. Select your photos from the appropriate drive and folder.
4. While photos are uploading, you can name your album and add a description.
5. Once uploaded, Facebook will show you each photo.
6. Add a caption if you'd like.
7. Tag a Friend. Tags are different on Facebook. You tag your Friends and the photo appears on their page and for all of your Friends and their Friends to see it. Be careful when tagging Friends.
8. You can choose one photo to be your album cover.
9. Click on the Organize tab to change the photo order in your album.
10. Click on the individual photo to edit individually - rotate it, share it to your profile, tag it (with a Friend), edit it (the information), delete it or make it your Facebook profile picture.
11. People can share your photos with their Friends and comment on your photos.
12. You can share with people who are not on Facebook (if you allow everyone to see your photos) by copying the link at the bottom and pasting it into an e-mail.

There is no batch download option.
