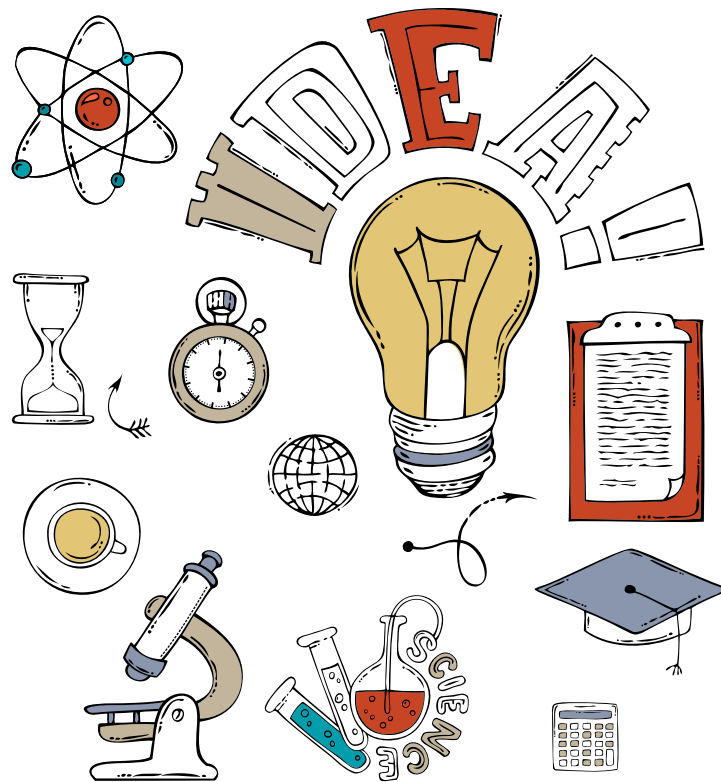


ZION-BENTON PUBLIC LIBRARY:

The library offers classes and online resources for adults who wish to learn skills to help their children or to enrich their lives.

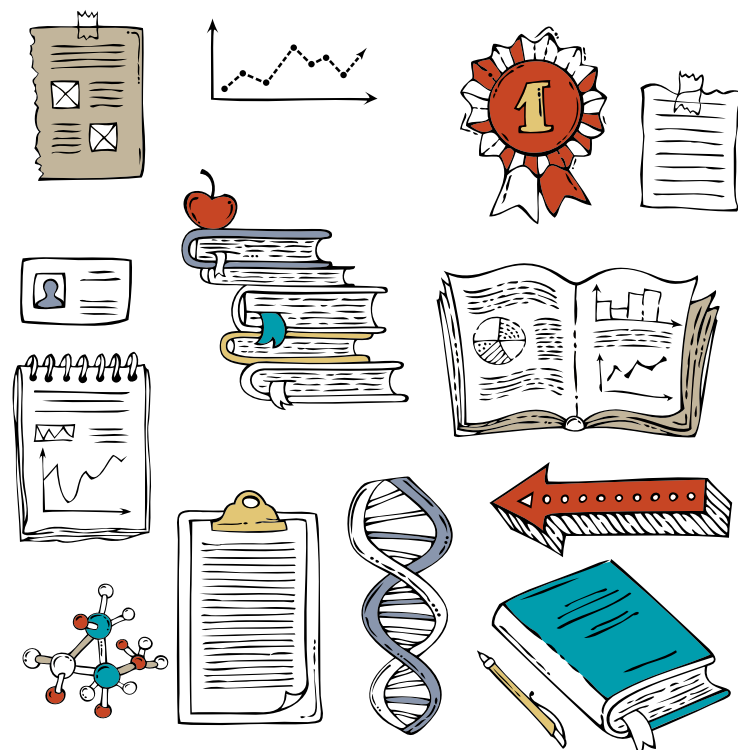
- **Classes for adults to learn skills in the library:**

- **Help Now powered by Brain Fuse** An Online Resource for students provides online help from expert tutors which can be accessed from home or mobile device.
 - **Online Tutoring** Students may submit a question in the online classroom and receive live, one-on-one assistance from a Brainfuse tutor, or use the skills building service to master a concept or skill through state-aligned online lessons.
 - **Writing Lab** which provides expert online writing assistance Students can upload a paper to the 24-Hour Writing Lab and Brainfuse experts will provide constructive feedback and other assistance,
 - **SkillSurfer** a learning library that contains thousands of lessons, quizzes, and tests to help students master academic concepts
 - **Language Lab** Allows a student to connect with a language tutor for help with foreign language classes.
- **Student Homework Help**
Free Tutoring assistance from high school tutors. Tue & Thu 4:00 - 5:30pm
- **Mango Languages**
Online Language courses for students and adults. There are more than 40 foreign language courses available and 16 English as a Second Language (ESL) courses in this online resource.
- **3D Printing Certification, Coding and other Tech Instruction**
The library provides hands on classes for teens.
- **Summer Reading**
The Zion Benton Public Library offers summer reading programs for teens in which they read books, keep logs and win prizes.

The Ages and Stages Questionnaire (ASQ) Screen your child to see if they are on the right track in 5 areas (Communication, Gross Motor, Fine Motor, Problem Solving & Personal Social)—Free
- **Library Preschool Programs**
The library offers story times, raising readers, playdates, playing with all 5 senses programs to encourage reading readiness and personal social development.
